Johnston's camp

April THURSDAY 21 (112-254) 1904

Self plowing Samson field
Cloudy and looks like rain
Finished plowing the other field
This evening started to rain

FRIDAY 22 (113-253)

Good Friday
Self & Samson digging the garden in morning
Several more boys & girls in the evening
& Indian boys arrived from Mountain camp
Started to rain in afternoon

SATURDAY 23 (114-252)

Overcast & party watched to top of the hill
and camped. Five Samson of after the house
Self working in garden
Sunday 24
Day of rest. Grass on hill
A few Indian women from the river
Evening of in the river
Fine warm day
