Remold to Sawmills putting up the fence
and garden in river part of day
A fine clear day self working with Indians

APRIL THURSDAY 27 (119-247) 1906

Working with Indians today
Went at Remold
To Indians
To boat of the house of Indians - sawmills around
with saw. House. from 6-7 noon saw clear lake
Two camps this day up to 7 noon here at the present time

FRIDAY 28 (120-246)

Still busy with Indians
Went in before
conditions fine weather
quite a number of Indians around

SATURDAY 29 (121-245)

Very busy today
Went to sawmills and back to river
Working all day
Sunday 30
