with the mail man he is in the Air Service

Thu 9 1 below this morning and mild all day  
KD Birley left by mail truck I got busy at job  
around the place cloudy, and mild to night

Fri 10 Very mild all day and blowing a South  
West Wind started to thaw this evening  
Duncan went over to Ranch 24 today  
35 above zero to night

Sat 11 Very Mild Fred came over with  
Harold and his Mother I drove over  
and got the mail very cloudy to night  
and very mild

Sun 12 fine this morning but  
cloudy and overcast  
started to snow towards evening  
Fred went to Birley  
this evening
