Wed 26 6 below this morning cold stormy all day
with a cold N E Wind Fred got
the mail

Thu 27 6 below this morning snowed during the night
blowing a cold wind all day snowed a little

Fri 28 18 below this morning but fine and mild
all day Fred went to R. to see the Horses
8 below to night
