cloudy and overcast 42 Above zero

Sat 5 A fine clear day and blowing warm West
Wind the snow nearly all gone around
the place I drove to but the did not
get in until Sat, ~~Fred speaking at~~
~~Thaxton~~ the roads very dry

Sun 6 Very warm, all day
