September 1940

Mon 2 Cold this morning, a light frost during the night. Frank drove to 24 B where B. McLeod will cut our castorbeans. Went to work for the beans.

Tue 3 Cold this morning, Fred went to the lake to start for 2 hours, blowing a N wind but heavy, tried all day, nearly all the forenoon, busy cutting the crop.

Wed 4 A fine mild day blowing a strong West Wind. Frank starting at 24. Fred coming at Henderson. Cold to night.

Thu 5 Fred got back this morning and went to work for Hanson. Clouds and rain. Castor beans started to come which.

Fri 6 Cloudy and cold all day. McLeod had a lot of trouble with the binder but he finished the cutting late to night. Fred starting for Hanson. Very cloudy and cold to night.
