- Mon 16 Blowing a cold North Wind I was busy  
at the wood pile Duncan but a load  
of Green wood. Jack McLeod outfit left for  
Fort Nelson
- Tue 17 Cold with fog this morning Duncan hauled  
2 loads of firewood cold all day
- Wed 18 8 Below this morning and cold all blowing  
a strong east wind I drove over and got  
the mail Duncan but a load of wood
- Thurs 19 Very Mild Duncan hauled 2 loads of  
fire wood a few trucks busy hauling wheat  
to Dawson Creek. Very cloudy to night  
and blowing a strong East Wind
- Fri 20 Continues fine Mild weather Duncan but  
a load of firewood but came home to night
- Sat 21 Weather fine very mild this day but a load  
of fire wood I drove over and got the mail  
at Dawson at Thorsens hall
- Sun  
22 Cold and stormy with snow
