fall of snow I drove over and got the mail  
cold and stormy Fred & Russ  
drove over to Bishop for a visit

Sun 22 6 below this morning blowing a cold N. E. wind  
I drove to town with some mail this morning  
Safel section of 2 Boys arrived from Moberly Lake  
the 2 Boys have been called up for the Army  
and come here to see the doctor.

Tue 24 21 Below this morning and blowing a cold East  
Wind Fred went over to help someone to get down  
fire wood
