a North Wind blowing.
- Tue 7 Blowing a cold North Wind and Very Cloudy
Snowed towards evening and very cold
Willie arrived by Plane from Prince George
- Wed 8 Cold and Stormy Willie came over to see us
he is staying in town we had no mail
- Thu 9 A fine mild day Angus brot the mail
Very mild to night
- Fri 10 Very Mild this Morning blowing
a strong S.E. Wind
- Sat 11 Very Mild and blowing a strong S.W.
Wind Angus & Willie went for the mail
the Berleys came for a visit
- Sun 12 A hard frost last night but fine and warm
all day
- Mon 13 A fine mild day I drove over to town
this morning the roads are fairly good
and drying up fast cold and cloudy
to night
