Mon 4 weather fine we drove over with

some farming and also put a crop
in S. Applegate place. I was busy in the garden
I planted some onions and some seeds in
the tubbed.

Tue 5 A fine clear day I was busy in the garden
the U.S. Army started at the road for
Fred

Wed 6 Fred drove up at noon today he went
over and got the mail I was busy in the garden
I put in onions and other seeds

Thu 7 Fred went over to R 24 to put in some
wheat Willie & Henry from J. Land
turnips & carrots weather fine but blowing
A strong East wind cloudy this evening
