- Fri 5 Rained during the night and a few heavy showers this morning cloudy and overcast drove bus in the garden
- Sat 9 A few showers this morning and very cold cloudy and overcast We got the mail in the afternoon biggest Willie packing for Macleod
- Sun 10 A fine clear day Mrs. Mitchell and one of her boys came on a visit
- Mon 11
- Tue 12 frost last night a fine clear day tried plowing self working in the garden. Blowing a cold North Wind to night
- Wed 13 Cold and stormy wind from north tried plowing. He went for the mail afternoon Willie came on a visit to night
- Thu 14 Cold this morning but fine and mild all day I drove to town with some mail tried plowing Duncan arrived this evening 5.45 am, he is reported to have discovered in charlie lake this evening
- Fri 15 frost last night had finished plowing and dried part of the field I planted a few potatoes a few showers this evening
- Sat 16 cold last night cloudy and overcast we drove over and the mail
- Sun 17 a fine warm day
