Fri 5. 14 Below this morning. Fed as before. Cold and clear all day.

Sat 6. 12 Below this morning but a fine clear day. Fed as before. Very cloudy this evening.

Sun 7. Blowing a strong north wind with snow.

Mon 8. Stayed at zero. A fine clear day. Fed as before.

Tue 9. Blowing a strong west wind. Very cold all day. Fed as before.

Wed 10. A fine clear morning. Wind from north. Fed as before.

Thu 11. Cold and stormy with snow blowing a strong north wind. Fed as before.

Fri 12. Continuous cold and stormy wind from north. Fed as before.

Sat 13. Blowing a cold north wind with snow. 14 below this morning. Driven to town for a few supplies. Fed as before.
