Wed 17 A fine clear day and very mild all day Fred as before cloudy to night and very mild

Thu 18 Snowed during the night and still snowing and blowing a N.E. wind John Arrived from Sukkiny Post Fred as before

Fri 19 Blowing a strong West wind very mild Fred as before

Sat 20 20 above this morning cloudy and overcast Wind from West I went to town for fire supplies Fred as before

Sun 21 Blowing a strong West wind very mild

Mon 22 Very cloudy and looks like snow wind from North East Fred as before

Tue 23 Blowing a cold North wind with snow and continued all day Fred as before

Wed 24 still blowing with snow wind from North cleared up towards evening and got cold Fred as before
