

August 1943

Tue	6	Cold last night and heavy fog this morning, but cleared up towards noon
Sat	7	Cloudy and overcast this morning. Tried cutting cord wood. We drove over to town in the afternoon
Sun	8	Rained during the night and a few heavy showers all day
Mon	9	Cloudy this morning, cleared towards noon, blowing a strong east wind. Tried cutting cord wood
Tue	10	Cloudy, but cleared up towards noon. Tried as before
Wed	11	A fine clear day. Blowing a strong west wind. I drove over to see the man , tried as before. Mr. Berg got back, sun, now
Thu	12	A heavy fog this morning. Tried cutting cord wood. Cloudy this evening
Fri	13	Rained this morning. Very cloudy and overcast. Wind from southwest. Tried cutting cord wood
Sat	14	A fine clear day and very hot. We drove over to town in the afternoon
Sun	15	Weather fine
Mon	16	A fine clear day. Tried window work at Smith's Mill
Tue	17	Continued fine weather, but very warm and dry. Tried to burn cloud this evening
Wed	18	Very cloudy. Sports at St. John's today. Bad rain today. And then went to the sports. A few showers in the afternoon
Thu	19	A fine clear day. Sports again today. Tried as before. Cold to night
Fri	20	Fine and clear this morning. Tried as before
Sat	21	A thick fog this morning and very cold. Tried as before. We drove over to town towards evening
