Kick ~~from~~ a Darrugan Indian
who died suddenly at the Reserve
5 days

Tuesday 20
a fine clear day self busy in office
cloudy towards evening with a little rain
& thunder River falling

Wednesday 21
cloudy but cleared up and very hot
self as yesterday. a few Indians came in
from the Reserve

Thursday 22
cloudy and overcast but cleared up toward
noon and very warm. Chief Taylor
left for Bush Camp.
Self sowed some Dulce oat
& a little hardies barley today
busy in office
