Sunday 22

a fine clear day self took a walk up to the Ranch.

Monday 23

Self in store a while usual work at the stable. Heavy after hours the water falling. Contains fine with a stormy gale of west wind.

Tuesday 24

Self working at stable. Heavy at night. The Indians put away off from the water. Smith's boat around from the crossing this evening and continued on her way to N. H. Chief Const. Pearson's went up as passenger on a boat to N. H.
