Wednesday 25

Self busy as yesterday. Tom Saunders & Frank Wright ascended from the Mountains where they have been prospecting during the past summer. Wright will winter somewhere below here. Tom Saunders is going out to Edmonstone.

Thursday 26

Self as yesterday. The Indians nearly all gone. Tom Saunders left this morning for the Crossing. Blowing a strong gale again today water falling.

Friday 27

Self finished the stable this evening. The first snow of the season fell this morning about 2 in of snow but melted all day. A party came down from Cache Creek on a raft. He met Smith's boat above here having been stuck on a bar and just got off.

Saturday 28

A fine clear day. The snow all gone. Self & Johnny in the buck making roads for hauling fire wood.

Japans wife very sick. Japans & Montigine are the only ones left. The rest are all patched off.

Sunday 29

Japans wife died early this morning. Self went up the hill and saw the Indians. A man passed down the River this morning.

Monday 30

Self made a coffin for the dead women and in the afternoon we went up the hill and buried her. Blowing a cold wind all day. The dead body arrived from Adieless camp & reports a woman very sick. Still no signs of Smith's boat from the Hope.
