The Mail left for Prince Rupert this morning they crossed in a canoe the mail also left for H. Hope. Self & George cutting fire wood

Wednesday 6

A fine clear day but cold with a north wind. Self at odd jobs got Mr Birley of Perillous to shoo the team a lot of ice running again today

Thursday 7

Cold the boys hauling hay self making a hay rack a lot of ice running 2 H. Below Luss

Friday 8

The River frozen over today and is still rising. Cold & stormy with snow towards evening boys hauling hay

Saturday 9

Continues cold & stormy with snow the River freezing over in good shape the boys went for a load of Hay 30 bags 2 this morning

Sunday 10

Snowed all day with a cold north wind. Cleared up in the evening

Monday 11

A fine clear day and much sun. Self at wood pile the boys went for hay

Tuesday 12

Snow all day. Cleared up at evening the boys hauling hay. Ice still weak and overflowing. Old bank came up from the flats
