about noon self at job felt  
The Boys hauling firewood

Thursday 15

a fine clear day self in office  
J Compa & Penell arrived from  
N Hope Compa went on to Pouce Coupe  
Penell is to wait here for Mr Bailey

Friday 16

Continues fine the Boys hauling  
hay on top the Hill self in  
store Mr Parsons arrived from  
N Hope

Saturday 17

Continues fine weather self  
in office mail arrived from  
N Hope & Pouce Coupe Mr Marshall  
also arrived a lot of people arrived  
and a lot of pens sold

Sunday 18

Blowing a strong gale of wind  
all day snow nearly all gone  
the mail left this morning  
4 passengers went out
