April 18

Wednesday

Self in store 3 Indians arrived from the north also Joe Apperson arrived from up the Cut/Banks they all brought a few fish and peaches then Dept

Thursday 19

The Indians all left this morning Self Plowed the garden behind the house the ice breaking up in front of the Post
Continues fine weather

Friday 20

Self & Boys finished plowing the garden in front in afternoon we planted it with potatoes also planted a few potatoes behind the kitchen in the evening I received my hot beer
Continues very fine weather

Saturday 21 April 1917

Started to rain this morning and continued all day Self in store The mail arrived from Plover Cape this evening

Sunday 22

The mail left this morning for Plover Cape and also for K Hope the ice getting bad showers all day

Monday 23

Cold with a few showers the boys went up to their home to drink and put in water

Tuesday 24

A fine clear day Self sunbathing in store put in a few seeds the ice went up in front of the Post but formed again in the lead
