Monday 17

a lot of Indians around looking for  
debt I gave Dept 5 a few of them  
Premier Brewster and 6 others arrived  
from Hudson Hope and camped  
across at the Police Building.

Tuesday 18

The Government Party came across  
and stayed almost all night  
and then left on their way down  
a fine clear day, the Indians  
left for their camps this evening.

Wednesday 19

centering fire self fixing up the  
stove the School Inspector  
arrived from Peace Camp and camped  
on the other side.

Thursday 20

self in office a few Indians arrived  
the River came up over 2 ft.

Friday 21 September 1911

self opening up hands content  
fine weather

Saturday 22

self in store blowing a strong  
gale of wind all day Mr. Brewster  
arrived with his Park train  
the mail got in this evening.

R. Wood arrived from H.H. on his way out  
River left with Mr. Brewster

Sunday 23

The mail left this morning wood  
also left for Peace River

Monday 24

Very cold last night self & Johnson  
taking up potatoes 6 men arrived in  
a boat from H.H. and camped  
on the other side.

Tuesday 25

a fine clear day  
self & Johnson as yesterday
