Continues very cold 35 below
self got timber for a hay rack
2 men arrived from Packer Camp
on their way to Hardsams Hope

Wednesday 12

38 below zero this morning the boys
hauling hay self at job
The young wolf arrived & brought
a little news and returned home
again after getting a few supplies

Thursday 13

a little milder today 30 below this
morning Ogline crossed the
River this morning with a team
self at job the boys hauling
hay

Friday 14

Snowing all day Sakuma
arrived & brought a few feet
free apparatus & Wolf arrived
self in store the boys hauling
hay had a visit from Mr. Campbell

Saturday 15

Continues cold snowing again
towards evening self at job
the boys hauling fire wood

Sunday 16

a little milder today self out
looking at my traps the snow
about 1 1/2 ft deep
