56 below this morning and continued
cold all day the boys hauling fire
wood all Kintzack down around
old lady Crawford with Deben's team

Friday 28
Continues cold Kintzack & old
Mrs Crawford still down around
with Deben's team the boys went
for a load of oats started to snow
this evening

Saturday 29th Dec 1917
a lot of snow fell last night
very cloudy & looks like more
snow a little milder to day
the boys hauling firewood
self went after a wolf but did
not get him

Sunday 30
cloudy & mild and looks
like more snow

Monday 31
A fine mild day self in
office the boys went for hay
6 Indians arrived from the
north this evening they brought
very little fur as they have had
very poor luck on account of
the cold weather
