Thursday 28

Blowing a strong Chinook
wind. Beattie & McKenna
left for St. John's this morning
Mr. Pealy & Ogilvie left for North
Blair to buy furs. One man
around this evening from St. John's
hauling a sled he is on his way
to Edmonton because men for
a load of bats

March 1918

Friday 1

a fine warm day blowing a
strong wind. I approached
the Wolf around and bought
a little Moose meat they have
killed 3 Moose at the 3 River
Self in store

Saturday 2

Cold & stormy with snow
around evening wind from north
Self in office the boys went for out

Sunday 3

Continues cold & stormy with
snow wind from north
Davis & Japlasia arrived from
Montreal's camp they report
a white man having been coming
in with 2 horses & sled but found
when men had died and then
they saw the Moose Rifle & Cape and
they think the man is larger than
some others dead. I reported the
matter to the Police
