 but very mild self in office
 Prince passed up on his way home
 with freight heavy hauling wood

Thursday 7th
 Cold & stormy with snow mist
 from N.E. the boys hauling logs out
 self in office

Friday 8th
 Self in office Adieless & 2 others
 arrived the mail arrived at
 noon and report a very hard
 trip snow very deep

Saturday 9th
 Self at act jobs the mail left this
 morning the boys went for a
 load of oats a fine clear day
 but cold

Sunday 10th
 18 below this morning
 a fine clear day

Monday 11th
 weather cold 20 below this morning
 self in office the boys went for
 a load of oats Mr Prince passed
 down the River on his way to
 Taylor's Flat
