

April 1918
Saturday 20

A fine clear morning but snow
& rain in afternoon still
no mail

Sunday 21

a very fine day. Self & Johnny
went to the upper branch and made
a few fires

Monday 22

contents fine self in store
still no mail. Put in a few
potatoes in the back garden this
evening

Tuesday 23

Sowed $5\frac{1}{2}$ acres of wheat today
at B Branch and 1 acre barley
a lot of trees being all over
the County. Cloudy and looks
like rain or snow

April 1918

Wednesday 24

cold and stormy with snow
wind from north. Cleared up
about noon. Self in office
a lot of ice going down the
River

Thursday 25

a fine clear day put in 4 stks
oat on top of Hill. a lot of ice
running all day looks as if the River
has broke all the way up. but it
went out very easy

Friday 26

cold and stormy all day put
in 3 stks oat. Johnny looking
after the store

Saturday 27

a fine clear day. Joe Apperson
arrived from the S River he has killed
4 Beavers. Lately the Police & Agri
came across this evening
