Self in store with Indians.
3 men passed down the River
in a canoe this morning
a fine clear day.

Thursday 23

contours fine self in office
the River still falling.

Friday 24

a fine clear day self in office
the lady Mackintosh arrived this
morning. Mr. Battersman on
board on his way to N. Hope.

Saturday 25

a fine clear day. The lady
Mackintosh left for N. Hope
this morning self in office.
The Mackintosh arrived here
this evening from N. Hope.

Sunday 26

cloudy with a few showers.
The boat left this morning
for P.P.

Monday 27

a fine clear day self in
office a few Indians
around water still falling.

Tuesday 28

cloudy blowing a strong west
wind. The River rising.
3 men arrived from Smith River
bringing for board. Self in
store.
