Mr Boyd District Manager left today at noon for Surrangan with a canoe. Cap Haight passed down in afternoon for R.P. self in store a lot of Indians arrived from Sabatich's camp

Thursday 22

Self out at Hay in put up 8 loads

Friday 23

blowing a strong gale from west cutting Hay all day. Indians arrived from Sabatich's camp

Saturday 24

cutting grain out all day the River crossing up Surrangan & Durrigan arrived

Sunday 24

Rain this morning

Monday 25

Rain again today the River falling

Tuesday 26

cutting wheat a fine clear day

Wednesday 27

put up 6 loads summer out
