(89-8)

Thompson a General collecting

then in the evening a fine frosty day

WEDNESDAY 26

(89-9)

Set out looking for the best places
all day. had several good finds had
very different travelling. no big snow now
under nightfall Samson built
back & Quince as before
staying a strong pile of wood from 8.11.

DECEMBER

THURSDAY 27

(89-6)

1906

Set out of the day
and did some fire wood
working in office
fire wood
and continued all night
Samson built

FRIDAY 28

Still raining. and collecting
cleared up Samson evening
Samson cutting wood
More Reafers got made as usual
which seems to be of him

SATURDAY 29

(89-5)

Set out with gold. Samson as yesterday
Reafers and a pile of wood for
which took him all day. Staying a strong
pile from the night out
Saw a lot of 21. (20.11)
A fine clear day but cold. (10.11.1906)
