1907

MONDAY, 16

(360-15)

Summons of some hunting and hunting  
in the old mine & staid. Self went up to the  
Island and cut down for wood.  
No. 10 still on rails track.

WEDNESDAY, 18

(352-13)

Summons of wood self having up a  
shed shell on platform. River froze over  
last night. Fine warm day.
