Rain nearly all day self in office  
River rising fast

Saturday 29  
Rain again to day cleared up about noon Mr Porteus & Link left on a raft for P.B.L. the motor boat arrived this evening about 11 PM

Sunday 30  
a fine clear day the s.s. St. Charles arrived from Ft Hope this forenoon and continued down the River the motor boat left for Ft Hope this morning and got back here this evening making the round trip in one day

Monday 31  
self taking inventory Johnny helping the motor boat left this morning for P.B.L. with Link & 2 others left for up the St. Lawrence River Mr Wilder & party started work on the Ft Hope telegraph line a fine clear day water falling

got a woman died

self a lot work was

self to dinner River

fine in of to

a for self
