 the 9th of September but laid up 5 days at Fish
 Lake waiting for an Indian the water
 very low in river and still falling

 cloudy and cold self at post feel
 a few settlers arrived with a team & Muggen
 they came up on the north trail

Saturday 5
 continues cold with a little rain
 self in office the mail arrived via
 passenger the Gov. Assessor a lot of
 people around

Sunday 6
 The mail left this morning cloudy
 and cold with rain
