a fine clear day from Indians around  
self busy with Indians. The 25<sup>th</sup> Pine  
Pass around from Hope this evening. I got a  
few supplies by it from Hope.

Friday 16

Self busy in store a lot of Indians around  
weather fine. Jean B. Lebonde around from  
up the South Pine for a few supplies put  
in a few seed in gutz garden.

Saturday 17

a fine clear day self in office. The  
River rising fast. Very hot.

Sunday 18

Very hot but a walk up the Hill leaves  
coming out but grass very poor  
for appearance around.

Monday 19

Self & boys planting potatoes see put in  
7 sacks. Strong a strong gale of west  
wind. River now nearly 3 ft.

Tuesday 20

Self at old jobs between a strong gale  
Wasklulle & 2 others around from up  
the Halpin River and bought a few  
pigs and paid their debts.

Wednesday 21

Self busy with Indians a lot of  
people around the mail around  
2 Government men around from River  
Camp to look for land for. Esc. Soldiers
