Monday 11

a fine clear day and looks as if the weather was going to continue. George and Angus started to make hay on top of the Hill. The H B Messenger from Fort Graham passed down the River on a canoe this morning on his way to Victoria with some furs.

Tuesday 12

Bugs at Hay a little rain toward evening. Self at work.

Wednesday 13

Hay not much done 8 men worked on the other side with a number of horses self in office weather fine

Thursday 14

Bugs at Hay a fine clear day self very busy a few men passed down the River from up above H Hope

Friday 15

Self & Angus started ~~at~~ 8 loads of Hay a fine clear day getting looking after the boat

Saturday 16

Started to Rain about 7 AM and stopped on Hay cleared up towards evening

Sunday 17

Rain again today Mr. Sacher operative left this evening for Edmonton on his way to Athabasca Landing along with 2 others
