Went down to old Post. The SS & a Thresher arrived about noon with a big load heavy equipment. Got for the settlers after unloading part of her cargo then left for the Hope. Rained part of the day.

Monday 3

Weather fine. Very busy. A few Indians arrived. A Thresher passed old Post on her way to Peace River. Very busy about 4 P.M.

Tuesday 4

Blowing a strong gale of wind. Surge & McLeod left for Lake Louise with the Post team of 16 horses. We would go with them as far as the Pine Post. Very busy at all jobs.

Wednesday 5

Weather fine. 3 Callions & 12 horses arrived and paid some debts. Very busy. Clear & cold towards evening.
