will go up and pay treaty money  
had a visit from Mr & Mrs Bowassa  
who came down for the trunks  
which was left at the old Post. last fall  
the company has built a new  
house for them at fish creek

Saturday 9

I went up with Mr Laird to Fish  
creek where he paid treaty to  
the Indians we got back about  
10 P.M. the B.C. Bishop bought  
Mr Eastons house and garden  
which they will use for a mission  
weather fine

Sunday 10

Mr Laird & party left today at noon  
for Sunwegan weather fine

Monday 11

a fine clear day Brants working  
up potatoes self pretty up over  
little more work

Tuesday 12

self busy as yesterday Laird  
helping had a visit from Bowassa  
Monyisto very bad
