Sunday 19

Weather fine but cold. Self & Mrs B  
drove up to Fish Creek.

5 teams left with Joe Clark's freight  
for Siskimaw this morning

Monday 20

Duncan left <sup>with</sup> freight for Fish Creek  
this morning. Self cutting fire wood  
had a visit from Mrs Ross at Moore  
Wind from North with snow -  
Willie went up for a load of feed  
- but cleared up later
