Willie brought down a load of feed

a fine clear day but a little cold  
I went up to high bank after dinner  
Willie took his motor out for a drive  
up to the McLeods.

I heard that three  
freight trains got back from Selkirk  
and for loads got back from Edmonton  
is said be leaving shortly for the North
