Sunday 18

Continues very warm the flat here covered with water rushing down from hills to the River. T. C. Brady brought down about 3 tons of freight he had to make 2 trips to bring it down, he camped here for the night.

Monday 19

Very hot snow nearly all gone. Brady and Man left this morning for Halfway River, a lot of water on the ice. Bill Peters & Patner got back from Hudsons Hope. They went up there to look for a home stead but it did not suit them. Miller & Doremus brought down 6 little loads of hay. The Slaying is now finished, as the snow is nearly all gone. The McLeads are going to leave for the Sitkum River with freight to day, I expect they will have a nice trip.

Tuesday 20

Continues fine weather opened the Post house some of the States Kruger. Miller went up the hill with some Potatoes, self busy around the place. Clouds and started to rain toward evening wind shifted to N.W.

Wednesday 21

a hard frost last night but warm all day. Self went up the hill snow nearly all gone, a few more potatoes arriving every day. Had a visit from Mr. Pinch. Miller went up for Hay with the Wagon.
