the ground getting very dry  
Victoria Day

Friday 25<sup>th</sup>

Continues very hot cloudy in afternoon  
a few drops of rain busy in garden  
Fred came back from Carl. at noon  
and we went down to the old Pond for  
the Bergey. I bought from Harris and  
brought it up. I took the Princes  
children up the hill after supper  
Johnny Arnold from Big Creek

Saturday 26<sup>th</sup>

Weather fine George came down  
in afternoon and helped to plant  
Potatoes we put in 3 1/2 sacks of Potatoes  
Willie came down and gave us  
a little help
