Thursday 4

Snow & Rain in forenoon
 cleared up in afternoon
 cloudy towards evening,
 the 2 women left at noon
 for their home

Friday 5

a fine clear day blowing a strong
 west wind River rose about 1 1/2 ft
 I went up to High Creek
 the Company's freighter left yesterday
 for High Creek & Selkirk posts

Saturday 6

Rain this morning and continued
 till noon and then cleared up
 Fred went up for the mail which
 got in at noon. Weavers boat
 arrived this evening from the river

Sunday 7

A fine clear day. Weavers brought
 up about 33 tons freight as he had
 2 boxes of lumber here he took
 for Hope about 2 P.M. I went to
 look up to see the boys
 Willie was blowing at Jerry place
 cold towards evening

Monday 8

Cold last night but fine all day
 I & Fred digging potatoes. Cloudy
 towards evening and started to rain
 Fred sick with a bad cold
