A fine clear day busy fixing up mirring accounts Willie went up for the mail which got in after dinner the post had that Russell who shot himself a week ago died at Base camp

Sunday 31

Easter a fine mild wind from west had a few visitors

April 1929

Monday 1

blowing a strong west wind snow nearly all gone I went up to the post office with mail 3 Misses came down for mining licenses they are going north to the Nelson River a dance to night at Thorsens

Tuesday 2

Started to snow early this morning and continued till noon fell about 40 in of snow cold & stormy all day very cloudy towards evening Willie brought a load of feed with the wagon
