A fine clear day I hauled Manure to the potato field in forenoon. H Weaver Boat arrived about 3:30 P.M. with Knight & a few passengers. I went up to see Angus after supper he is busy plowing. River rising

Thursday 16

Started to rain early this morning and continued all day. H Weaver Boat left this morning for Hope

Friday 17

A fine clear day I was busy cutting wood in forenoon I went up to Angus place and fixed some fence. Bill Tracer was over then and cut 2 young studs.
