after staying a short time continued
on his way down

Sunday 26

Rained all night and all day
cleared up towards evening but
started to rain again

Monday 27

A fine clear day I went up with
the mail this morning and then I
went to Fish Creek. busy in garden
after dinner Frank came down and
helped a little Willie came down for
some skin to tan the oats
