Wednesday 14

The Indians all came in and got  
treaty. I was helping the doctor  
who was looking over the Indians.  
We finished and got down here  
about 7 o'clock and had Mr. Land  
& the Bishop to supper. The  
Bishop camped here for the night.

Thursday 15

got up at 5 this morning after  
breakfast I drove down ~~to~~ with  
the Bishop to the old Post where  
Mr. Land's party are. They left  
about 7 o'clock for Durvogan by  
a small boat. I went up  
to the P.O. and got the mail  
and then I went over to T. Bishop  
for eggs. The Umenak is  
expected this evening.

Friday 16

The Umenak arrived from the  
Crossing at noon and brought with  
a number of men to work on the  
D.A. Thomas and also some things.  
She is not going to H. Hope.  
Weather very hot. George started  
the hay I cut on top of the Hill.

Saturday 17

Weather very hot. George started  
and I calked it up. The Umenak left  
this evening for the day. The men are  
busy at the D.A. Thomas job by cut  
some wood in the bush.
