a fine clear day but cold. I went to Willis and fixed the roof on our granary. I then went over to Mr. Thorsens and paid him for some Lumber. Frank cut fire wood in forenoon. he went to see the Michelsons after dinner. Very cold and clear this evening.

Sunday 17

Very cold this morning. Mr + Mrs Monda son agent and Mr Fisher also Mr Vandyke came down for a visit they came in last night from ~~Portage~~ ~~Portage~~ they left at noon for Passu Camp a lot of ice going down the River. Very cold towards evening.
