fresh last night and cool all day. I went up to Guyes and planted Potatoes in his garden. Fred went over to his Homestead.

Thursday 22

a fine clear day I went up and planted the Potatoes on my land near Throssens. Duncan buy plowing their. Angus around at noon they report the roads in good shape.

Friday 23

Cloudy but cleared up at noon I went up and planted some more potatoes I put in 70 drills and a few squash. Duncan plowing he expects to finish tomorrow.

Saturday 24

Cloudy all day Frank went for hay at Guyes and I went for Thomas. Victoria Day they are having some sport at Throssens. The water going down in the River started to rain about 11 o'clock to night.
