10 below this cold all day wind N E it started to snow about 2 o'clock with a strong N E wind and continued until 10 o'clock. Willie & Lennie bought 2 loads of hay

Sunday 14

30 below this storming but fine all day 21 below at 10 o'clock this evening

Monday 15

15 below this morning blowing a North wind all day I drove up to Hallows place in afternoon. Willie bought the mail this evening the wind changed to North East about 9 o'clock and a regular Gale of wind with snow started and time very cold

Tuesday 16

Cold and stormy wind North East 21 below this morning. Willie went down at noon Lorraine bought a load of hay she had a visit from the Priest this evening Mr. Scouting drove from down very mild this evening
