The Indians report there are very several  
furs only killed 3 some small furs

WEDNESDAY, 25

(329-36)

Fine day looks like a Thursday  
The Indians started back this morning  
had much doing between cutting wood  
I went to my traps and got nothing

THURSDAY, 26

(330-35)

1903

A fine sunny day. Rain last night  
the hills here. With washing in the office  
only going the windows of the house  
Saw some at five o'clock  
The time is nearly that one of the fine weather  
has passed & set in

FRIDAY, 27

(331-34)

Another fine day very nice  
The Indians  
Walk in the office  
Saw some at five o'clock

SATURDAY, 28

(332-33)

Thomas started this morning but had to turn  
back again on account of bad ice

Sunday 29  
Thomas started again this morning  
back to Tim River crossing. The boys went along  
with him. The horse and pack were the only
