Wednesday 21

Cold this morning and a light fall of snow but cleared up towards noon. Frank's plowing. Fred went up to Montague. I was busy cutting firewood. Mild towards evening, 16 above zero.

Thursday 22

Cold this morning, a light frost last night, fine all day. Frank's plowing. Fred got the mail. I cut some firewood in the bush. A plain passed going East at noon to day.

Thosson finished thrashing for the season and sent his outfit home.

Friday 23

A fine clear day and very mild. blowing a warm West wind. Frank's plowing a number of trucks, hauling wheat to Dawn Creek.

Saturday 24

Rain early this morning and also a light fall of snow but cleared towards noon. I drove over and got the mail and I also went to the H B. Frank's plowing finished about 25 hours. Clear and cold to night.
